



FLINT










NORTH





Flint & Genesee Changemaker:

DR. AISHA HARRIS, HARRIS FAMILY HEALTH

In Flint, Dr. Aisha Harris has opened a unique kind of clinic called Harris Family Health. Unlike traditional clinics, this one runs on a direct care model allowing patients to pay a monthly fee to access care instead of waiting on insurance.

"Back in 2020, I was practicing medicine with a family doctor in Flint caring for patients while experiencing barriers in care," says Harris. "I felt that these patients deserved quality time and access to affordable care and decided that opening my own clinic was the best opportunity I had to shape our medical landscape in an impactful way."

Through the direct care model, Harris can provide flexibility for her patients. With

membership to Harris Family Health, patients pay a monthly fee to have full access to their doctor without having copays or coinsurance. They also have access to wholesale labs and medication through the clinic.

"This model empowers the patient and me to build a relationship and not have a rushed appointment," says Harris. "It helps me be patient-focused instead of appointmentfocused."

This model may be new to the area, but it isn't a new concept. Harris learned about this model while she was in medical school, and when she was ready to start her own clinic, she started connecting with others doing the



same thing. "I wanted to bring this to Flint to show the community there is a different way to access care," says Harris. "Flint deserves to the opportunity to see what can happen with membership-based care."

Domonique Clemons was born and raised in Flint. A graduate of Flint Southwestern High School, Clemons moved away from Genesee County to attend Michigan State University. After college, he stayed in Lansing and began working for a state legislator. However, he was drawn to come back to the community that raised him.

"I missed the closeness of the community, and I recognized that young folks were moving out of Genesee County," says Clemons. "I wanted to be the opposing force to that, so I moved back and started commuting for a few years."

Then, Clemons made some changes that kept him rooted in this community. In 2020, he ran for county commissioner in his district after the previous commissioner retired. After securing that seat, Clemons was elected Chair by the Board of Commissioners. There, he felt he was able to start making a positive change in his community.

"My goal was to provide residents with strategic economic development and placemaking in order to make Genesee County a great place to live, love, and play," says Clemons.

Then, another opportunity arose. With the resignation of the former County Clerk and Register of Deeds for Genesee County, Clemons was appointed to the role by the Genesee Circuit Court Judges. With that appointment, he has been able to broaden the work he started as a County Commissioner.

"In this role, my number one goal is to make government more accessible to residents," says Clemons. "I work to make it easy and convenient for individuals in our community to access our services and I protect the rights of individuals to vote safely and securely."

He has done so over the last few years by expanding the right to vote and ensuring that voting results are quick and accurate. He has also worked to get his office into more public-facing events so that they can be embedded in the community. Another initiative he passed was making Genesee County vital records free of cost to low-income individuals.

"I don't have any intention of leaving Genesee County at this point," says Clemons. "We have so much to offer including a world-class cultural center with arts and music. This county has a little bit of everything from its urban core to the suburban shell. We also have the largest county parks system in Michigan with a ton of recreation."

To Clemons, the area is unique compared to other places he's experienced. "The people in Flint & Genesee are different than anywhere else," says Clemons. "No matter if you've been here your entire life or just moved here, we're quick to wrap around and help each other. I have not seen

that outside of Genesee County." When he's not making moves as the County Clerk-Register, he spends his time in the community.

"I do quite enjoy downtown Flint," says Clemons. "I will spend an evening out on Saginaw Street, eating dinner at Spectacular Spudz, having drinks at X, and catching a show at the Capitol Theatre." Even though he keeps Flint close to his heart, he still finds time to explore the rest of the county like in Fenton where he suggests spending a night out at The Laundry or Fenton Fire Hall and catching a performance by the Fenton Village Players. On weekends, Clemons enjoys his time exploring the outdoors and frequenting Genesee County Parks.

"My current favorite hidden gem in Genesee County is the Mundy Miracle Commons operated by Mundy Township," says Clemons. "It has paved walking paths, and I go there to walk my dog. But the hidden gem of it is its beautiful Tai Chi and tea gardens where you can go to meditate."

Between work and recreation, Clemons has found that Flint & Genesee is a great place to "live, love, and play," and he hopes that others might discover the same.



FOUR SEASONS LIVABILITY/RECREATION

GENESEE COUNTY PARKS

Genesee County offers a vibrant four-season lifestyle that makes it an ideal place to call home year-round. In spring, explore blooming parks and trails, while summer invites you to enjoy the numerous lakes, beaches, and waterways. Fall brings stunning foliage and perfect weather for hiking and apple picking. Winter transforms the landscape into a playground for sledding, ice skating, and even snowshoeing. No matter the season, Genesee County provides endless opportunities for outdoor adventures and community connections.

GENESEE COUNTY PARKS & RECREATION

The parks system provides quality recreational opportunities for everyone while preserving natural resources with a variety of activities and programming at 25 parks and complexes throughout the county.

FOR-MAR NATURE PRESERVE & ARBORETUM

Immerse yourself in 383 acres of nature in Burton. For-Mar Nature Preserve & Arboretum was donated to Genesee County Parks by Forbes and Martha Merkley in 1970, and the former dairy farm has since grown into a certified arboretum with hiking and biking trails, beautiful gardens, meadows and lakes, and a barrier-free treehouse.

Open year-round, the nature preserve offers programming that emphasizes what can be found outdoors in all four seasons. In the summertime, enjoy watching the monarch butterflies hatch; in fall, see the 157 species of trees change color; in the wintertime, learn how to snowshoe; and in the spring, see For-Mar's gardens bloom.

CITY & TOWNSHIP PARKS

For those who love the outdoors, Flint & Genesee has plenty of places to explore. From playgrounds and splash pads where kids can run free to adult recreation like the disc golf course in Mott Park or the numerous kayak and canoe launches, outdoor recreation is top notch in Genesee County.

THE MOUNDS

Thrill seekers can find fun and excitement at The Mounds ORV Park in Mt. Morris. The 370-acre park offers trails, obstacles, and mud for off-road vehicles, dirt bikes, or whatever you want to get dirty. The park is open all year long with a huge event drawing in people from around the state on Thanksgiving morning. If you've always wanted to try your hand at "mudding," check out The Mounds ORV Park.

ACCESSIBILITY

Several parks throughout Genesee County have been designed to include for people with all abilities. At For-Mar Nature Preserve, its treehouse was built barrier-free to be accessible for all mobility needs. In Genesee Township, Mott Lake has a universally accessible kayak launch that gets users into the no-wake lake which connects to the Flint River Water Trail. The Splash Pad at Bluebell Beach near Flint offers a zero-depth, barrier-free surface, as well as a universally accessible playground.

Genesee County is home to the largest county parks system in Michigan. With 11,000 acres of woods, water, and fun, Genesee County Parks invite you to enjoy the great outdoors, have fun in the sun, and discover something new.

Once completed, the park will include a sledding hill, a universally accessible ballfield in cooperation with the Miracle League, a butterfly garden, a performing arts space, and a farmers' market. The complex also includes a new universally accessible ballfield in cooperation with the Miracle League of Greater Flint and continues to grow.






